- Analytical review of data by conducting a year over year and intensity-based analysis of data per site.
- Desk-based review of source data for water and energy, as well as assessment of renewable energy credit documentation for a sample of facilities.
- Visit to KDP's HQ in Burlington, MA with Corporate staff to review data consolidation and emissions calculation process, outcomes of KDP's own internal QA/QC procedure, discussion on key report claims, close out of site visit findings and data review queries and checks on completeness of data.
- One in-person site visit to Houston, TX operations as a representative site from the cold beverage side of the business with the objective of understanding sources of energy, uses of water and operational processes.
- **Interviews with Subject Matter Experts** for review of content selection and preparation processes related to the report sections in scope.
- **Report review** for identification of key claims, followed by request and evaluation of substantiation for relevant claims for the sections of the report in scope.
- Review of the report to SASB index draft for evaluation of conformance.
- Assessment on the application of the GRI reporting principles for content and quality in the disclosed sections.
- Review of the disclosure of information in the report.
